**ORDER DIRECTING CHILD'S PARENTS TO REPORT
PROBATION VIOLATIONS**

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that the above named child has been placed on probation to be supervised by an officer of this court and that such probation can only be successful with full cooperation of the child's parent or guardian.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the child's parents (or guardians/custodians) are hereby **ORDERED** to report all violations of the child's probation rules to child's Probation Officer immediately.

FAILURE TO REPORT such violations may result in the arrest of the parent (or guardian/custodian) and prosecution for **CONTEMPT OF COURT**. The penalty for Contempt of Court can include up to ten (10) days in jail and a fine of up to fifty dollars (\$50.00).

IT IS ALSO ORDERED that the parents or guardians/custodians fully cooperate with assessments that are ordered by the court and comply with any recommendations of those assessments.

THE COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the parent or legal guardian shall participate in the child's program of treatment and rehabilitation pursuant to T.C.A. 37-1-174 and to the extent necessary for enforcement, the court joins the parent or guardian as a party herein pursuant to T.C.A. 37-1-170.

FAILURE OF A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN TO TAKE REASONABLE STEPS TO CONTROL THE CHILD'S DELINQUENT OR UNRULY CONDUCT may result in the parent or legal guardian being ordered to participate in the child's program of treatment and rehabilitation including participation in and completing community service work.
