**Visitation Hours**

Tuesday:	6:00pm-8:00pm
Saturday:	9:00am-11:00am and 1:00pm-3:00pm
Sunday:	9:00am-11:00am and 1:00pm-3:00pm
Thursday:	6:00pm-8:00pm (Special Visits)

Visitation is held weekly on Tuesday, Saturday and Sunday. Parents / legal guardians may schedule appointments to visit their child during the regularly scheduled visitation hours outlined above. Visitation appointments may be scheduled on Tuesdays between the hours of 1:00pm and 3:00pm by calling (615) 862-8066 ext. 71018 or by following the prompt to schedule visitation.

Special visitation opportunities are provided each Thursday for youth who have achieved Level III status and required daily points. Additional information on special visitation will be provided within the parent handbook.

### Telephone Calls

Upon arrival, each child will be permitted to make at least two initial phone calls. Following the initial calls, a pay phone is available to make collect calls to family and friends through Amtel. **Medical Services**    **Director of Nursing:** Hixie Watters, R.N.B.S.

Medical services are available to all youth in Detention twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week as needed. The program has an onsite clinic managed by licensed nursing professionals who are available from the hours of 6:00 am to 10:00 pm daily. Medical services are provided by request or on an emergency basis as needed. The program provides a contracted physician who is onsite twice weekly and a licensed mental health professional. Medical services include sick call, physicals for all youth who have been in placement 10 days or longer, medication management and emergency care.
